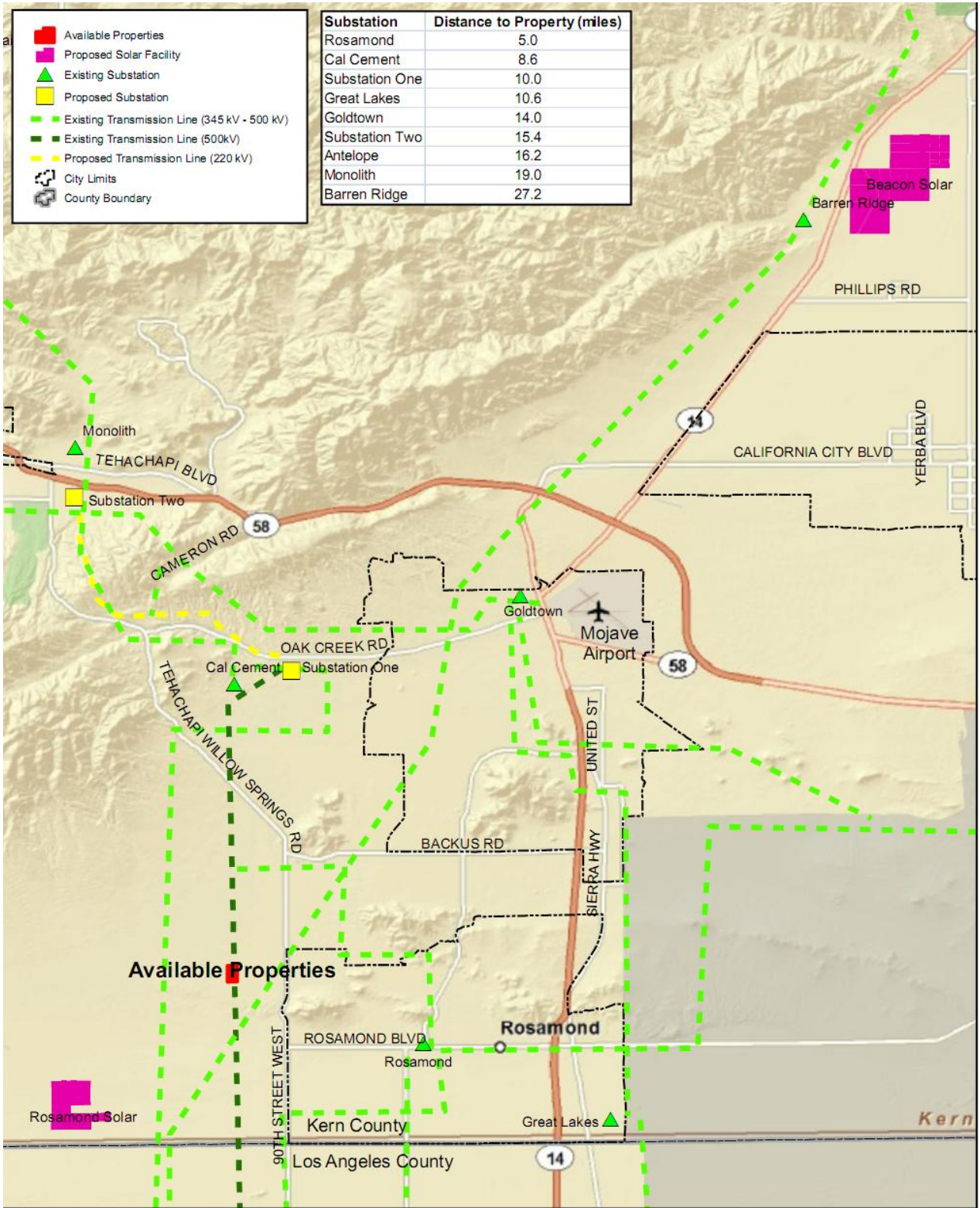

Offer	Both properties are for sale or option to purchase. The Baugh properties could also be leased but that is not the seller's preference. Properties can be sold separately.
Location	Located north of Hamilton Road, east of 105 th Street West, and south of Favorito Ave, and approximately 8.5 miles from the city center of Rosamond, California in Kern County. A regional location map is shown on page 3; a local map is shown on page 4.
Municipality	Unincorporated County of Kern near the City of Rosamond.
Assessor Parcel Numbers	Two ownerships of three rectangular parcels: 358-052-09, 358-052-10, and 358-052-11. An Assessor Parcel Map is shown on page 8.
Ownership	Rollin W. Baugh and Bonnie M. Baugh Living Trust and Remy Sanchez Alit.
Condition	The properties are currently un-entitled. They front and have access from 105 th Street West (dirt), Hamilton Road (paved) and Favorito Ave (dirt). Zoning is E (2 ½) RS FPS, Estate District 2 ½ Acres/Residential Suburban Combining District/Flood Plain Secondary Combining District. Highest and best use, utility grade energy power facility.
Environmental Context	Habitat is desert scrub. Flood: According to Flood Source, the majority of the property is located in Zone A; no base flood elevations have been determined.
500-kV Transmission Line Easement Bisects the Property	A new 500-kilovolt Southern California Edison power transmission line supporting the Antelope Transmission Project bisects the Baugh property; shading is minimal (see photos page 11). The property is located in Segment 3A of the transmission project (see map on page 5). Survey maps showing the easement bisecting the Baugh parcels are shown on pages 6 and 7. The area of the easement is 12 acres; the easement is 200 feet wide. The property owner maintains a right to a perpendicular crossing of the easement area.
Other Significant Factors	<p>The demand for new energy sources from renewable resources is growing. The County of Kern, long experienced in processing applications for oil and gas development, is currently processing solar and wind energy applications, including some near the subject property (see maps pages 9 and 10).</p> <p>The Antelope Transmission Project is the first major transmission project in California being constructed specifically to access multiple renewable generators in a remote renewable rich resource area. The project is a series of new and updated electrical transmission lines and substations that will deliver electricity from new wind farms in the Tehachapi area to SCE customers and the California transmission grid.</p>

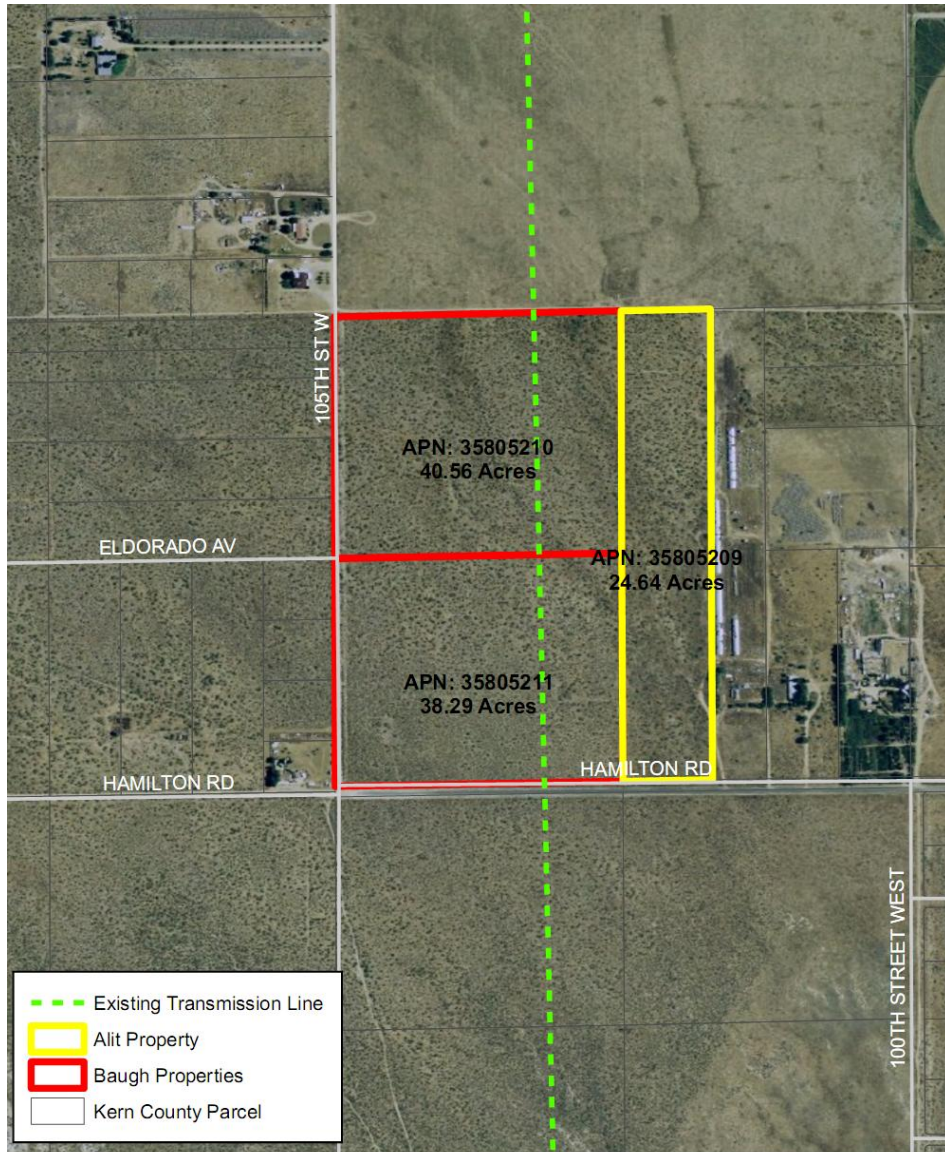

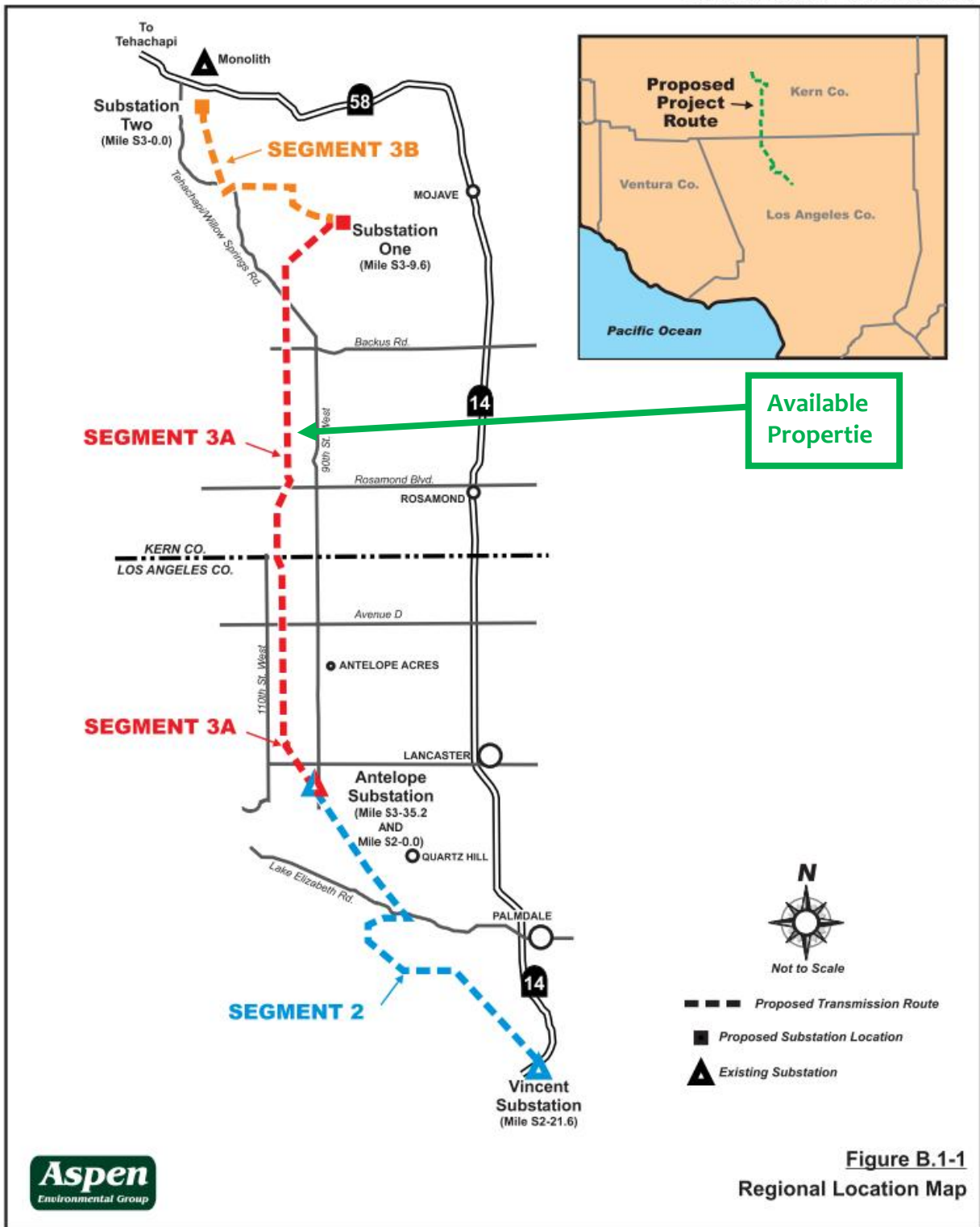

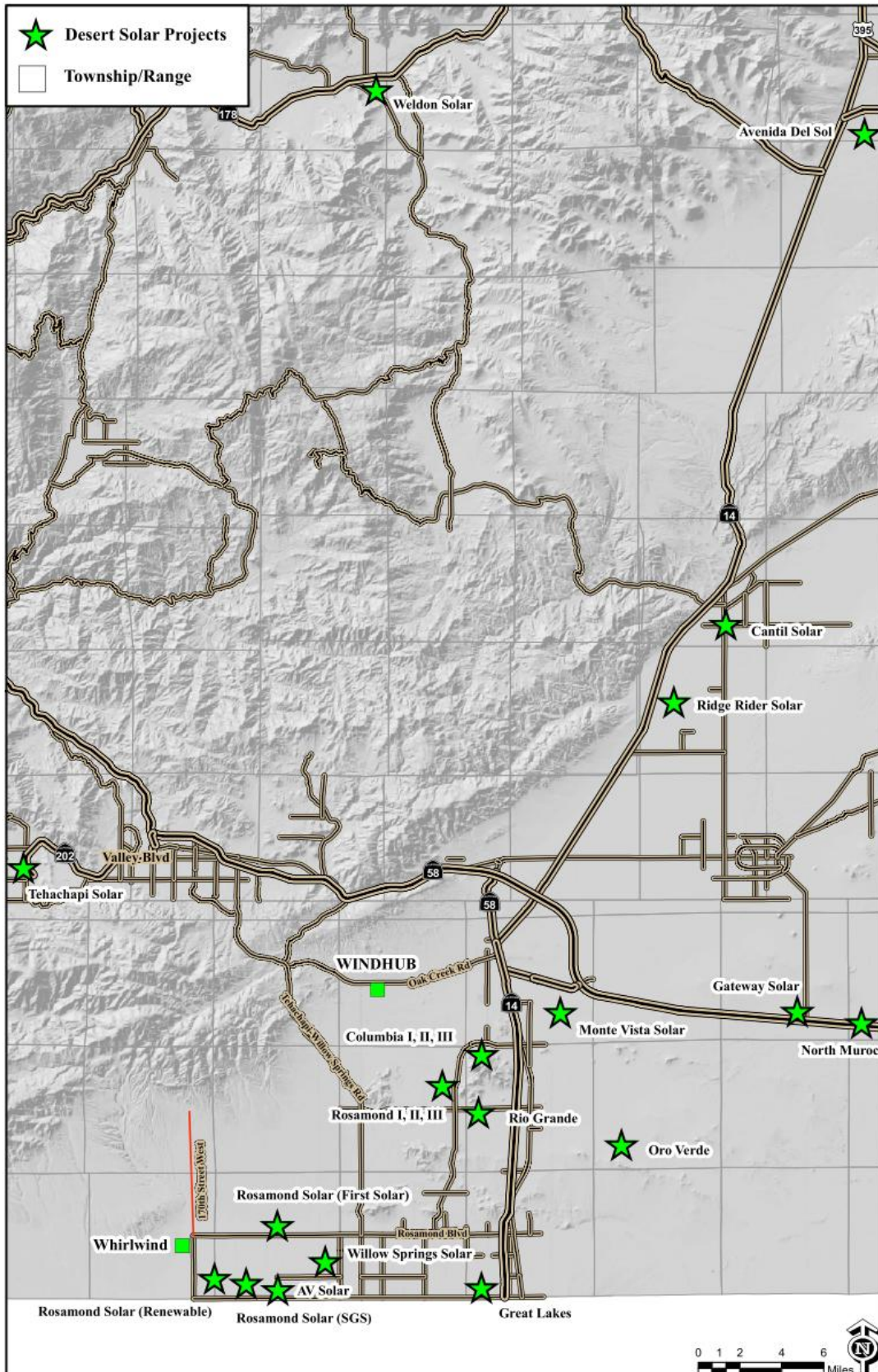
Baugh Property: 500-kV Transmission Easement, APN 358-052-11



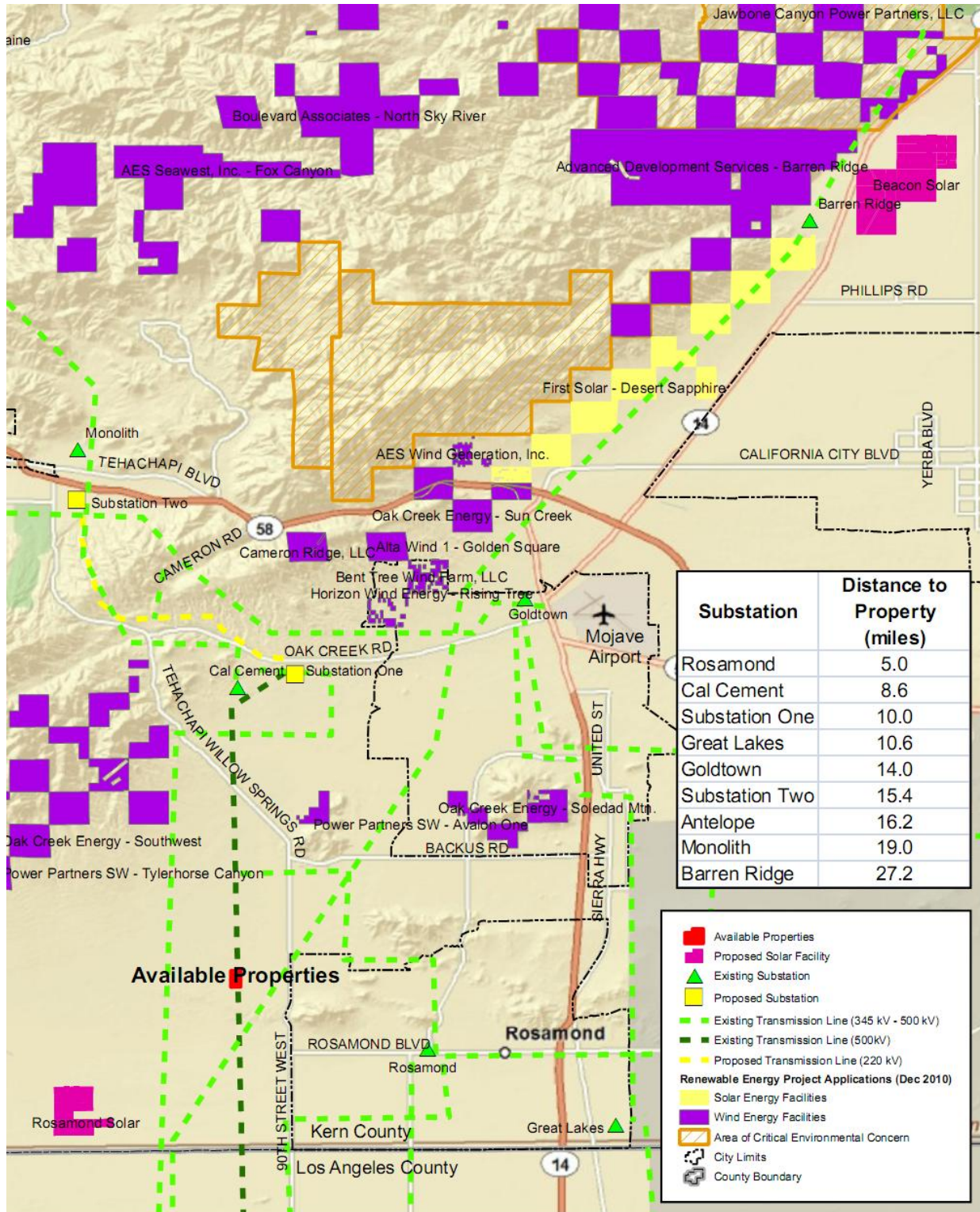

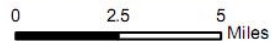
